## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES

**1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

**1.2** CYA prescriptions will apply as well as the Equipment Rules of Sailing to the extent that they apply, the rules of the participating classes and this Notice of Race.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

**2.1** Regatta is open to all boats of the International Tasar Class.

**2.2** Skippers wishing to register boats in this event must be members of Good Standing of a recognized yacht/sailing club/association or National Authority.

**2.3** At least one competitor in each boat shall be a member of NATA.

### 3. FEES

**3.1** \$30.00 CAN/USD per boat.

**3.2** Competitors may pay their entry fee at registration.

### 4. SCHEDULE

**4.1** Registration:

September 11                      From 10:00 to 12:00

**4.2** Dates of Racing:

September 11                      13:00 (Scheduled Time of First Warning)

September 12                      11:00 (Scheduled Time of First Warning)

**4.3** Competitors Meeting:

September 11                      12:00

### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

### 6. VENUE

The venue for this event will be the Jericho Sailing Centre, 1300 Discovery, Vancouver, BC. The sailing will take place on English Bay.

### 7. PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS 44.1 and 44.2 will be in effect.

### 8. SCORING

**8.1** The Low Point scoring system in Appendix A4.2 will apply.

**8.2** One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

**8.3** (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When 10 or more races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

## **9. THE COURSES**

**9.1** Courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

**9.2** The course to be sailed shall be displayed on the starting line boat no later than the preparatory signal.

**9.3** Courses may be shortened or abandoned according to RRS 32.

## **10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

**10.1** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4

**10.2** Decision to Race. The organizing authorities and the Jericho Sailing Centre Association will not accept any liability for material or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
