

NOTICE OF RACE
Flights of Spring
Regatta
April 21 & 22, 2007

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 CYA prescriptions will apply as well as the rules of the participating classes and this notice of race. In the event that there is a conflict between any preliminary NOR and this NOR, this NOR will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising will be restricted to Category "C".

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Skippers wishing to register boats in this event must be members of Good Standing of a recognized yacht/sailing club or National Authority.. Membership in the ILCA NA Region and NATA is recommended but not necessary.
- 3.2 Eligible classes are: International Laser, International Laser Radial, International Laser 4.7 and International Tasar.

4 FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee is \$20.00 CAN for single-handed boats and \$30.00 CAN for double-handed boats.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Racing for all classes will take place on Saturday, April 21, 2007 and Sunday, April 22, 2007.
- 5.2 Registration will take place on Saturday, April 21, 2007, between 10:00 and 11:30 hrs at the Jericho Sailing Centre.
- 5.3 Skipper's meeting will be at 12:00 hrs.
- 5.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first start of the first race on April 21 is 13:00 hrs. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first start of the first race on April 22 is 11:00 hrs.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1 The sailing instructions will be available at registration on April 21, 2007.

7 VENUE

- 7.1 The venue for this event will be the Jericho Sailing Centre, 1300 Discovery Street, Vancouver, BC, Canada. The sailing will take place on English Bay.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 8.1 RRS 44.1 and 44.2 will be in effect for all classes.

9 SCORING

9.1 The Low Point scoring system in Appendix A4.2 will apply.

9.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

9.3 (a) When 4 races or less have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When 10 or more races have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

10 THE COURSES

10.1 The course to be sailed shall be displayed on the starting line boat or at the preparatory signal for each class.

10.2 The courses to be sailed are as follows: all marks to be left to port.

10.3 A course diagram will be included with the sailing instructions

1	Standard Triangle	Start – 1 – 2 – 3 – Finish
2	Windward-Leeward	Start – 1 – 3 – Finish
3	Bermudan Triangle	Start – 1 – 2 – 3 – 1 - 3 – Finish
4	2 X Wind-Leeward	Start – 1 – 3 – 1 – 3 - Finish

11 PRIZES

11.1 Prizes will be given as follows: top three places in each of the participating classes. In addition, there will be a prize for top three youth participants in each of the International Laser Classes. In addition, there will be some draw prizes.

12 CHARTERS

12.1 There will be no charter boats available. However, Andy Hunt will try to accommodate any requests for borrowed boats providing such requests are made before April 15, 2007.

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

13.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk.
