1 Racing Area

Shilshole Bay to be sailed from the Shilshole Moorage, Seattle.

2 Race Management

Corinthian Yacht Club of Seattle

3 Rules

This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (2001-2004), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US Sailing), the rules of the individual classes associations participating in the regatta and by the complete sailing instructions for this event.

4 Eligibility and Entries

Solstice regatta eligibility: Thistle, Tasar, Laser and 29er. (For Thistles: Regatta is open to Thistle owners in the Pacific Northwest district only; no chartered boats are allowed; all Thistles must be TCA registered/measured and dues paid; Thistle Class Association owner card required; boats may be subject to measurement checks; sails limited to two jibs, two mains and one spinnaker, each with 'TCA Royalty Paid' label.)

5 Registration

See attached sheet for registration form. Early registration aids in the planning of the regatta. A \$20 late fee will be added to registrations received after close of business on Wednesday, June 16. Late registrations will also be available between 0900 and 1000 on Saturday in the CYC Shilshole Clubhouse.

6 Fees

\$40 for US Sailing members. \$45 for non US Sailing members. A \$20 late fee will be added to registrations received after close of business on Wednesday, June 16. A light dinner with no-host bar will be provided by the Seattle Thistle Fleet after racing on Saturday.

8 Safety

Competitors shall wear a life jacket or flotation garment other than a wet suit or dry suit at all times when racing. (For Thistles: All boats must carry equipment required by Thistle Class Association.)

9 Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be available at the CYC Shilshole Clubhouse on Saturday prior to the event and at the Skipper's Meeting.

12 Launching and boat parking

Launch ramp available for a daily fee payable at Seattle Parks and Recreation kiosk at launch area. Boat parking is available Saturday and Sunday at Shilshole, either in the parking lot just east of the dry storage pen or at main launching area at Shilshole.

13 Scoring

The Low-Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply. Boats that are OCS, do not finish, retire, or are disqualified will score points equal to the number of boats that raced in their class in that race plus one. Boats that do not start will score points equal to the number of boats that raced in their class in that race plus two. This modifies RRS Appendix A4.2 and A9.

14 Discarded scores

There will be no discarded scores. This modifies the General Sailing Instructions of the CYC Seattle Racebook.

15 Trophies

Trophies for skipper and crew of top five finishing boats in each class. (For Thistles: One completed race determines participation for Nationals. A minimum of two races is required to declare a District Champion. The Championship Perpetual Trophy. The Novice Champion Trophy. Larry Hanson District Trophy (family) for two generations in the boat. The Repechage Trophy for the highest finisher that was in the lower half of the fleet on the first day.)
